# Data Layout for SAT<sup>®</sup> and SAT Subject Tests<sup>™</sup> Electronic Score Reports

---

EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 2015 (UPDATED 12/1/2014)

## Introduction

Score reports provide score information that each student selects to send from up to six administrations of the SAT<sup>®</sup> and six administrations of the SAT Subject Tests<sup>™</sup>. The reports also include descriptive information if the student completed the SAT Questionnaire, and information about the student's high school.

The SAT is changing in March 2016. See [deliveringopportunity.org](http://deliveringopportunity.org) for more information about the redesigned SAT. The electronic data layout will change to incorporate the addition of new scores and subscores for the March 2016 test and after. **The layout will change at the beginning of the testing year, in October 2015, and will remain the same throughout the year.**

While the new scores will not appear until the March 2016 test administrations, other changes will commence at the beginning of the school 2015-16 year, including the collection of race and ethnicity data in line with federal guidelines. We are also aligning the length and content of several fields with Common Education Data Standards (CEDS). This has resulted in several fields moving from alphabetical coded values to numerical coded values. Lastly, we took this opportunity to logically reorder some fields so they are grouped with like fields.

For your convenience, we have created a revised SAT Data Layout Crosswalk that shows the prior data layout positions and the new data layout positions starting in October 2015. ## A Summary of New Developments

Here is a brief summary of the changes to data fields and the layout that we expect to make beginning in the 2015-16 year:

- The layout will be expanded to show both redesigned and pre-2016 SAT<sup>1</sup> scores.
- The SAT Subject Test codes will change. SAT Subject Tests and scores will not change.
- All date fields will be changed to YYYY-MM-DD format.
- Some codes that are currently alphabetic will be revised to be numeric.
- Electronic Score Reports will be delivered through the College Board website to enable easier downloading. Other formats for score delivery may be added as well.
- Changes to the collection of race and ethnicity data, and other demographic data, will be implemented.
- Some logical regrouping of like fields will be undertaken.

1. Please note: "pre-2016 SAT" refers to the exam being administered until the launch of the "redesigned SAT" that will be administered beginning in spring 2016.

**Score Report Delivery and Data Access**

Another change we will make with the 2015-16 school year is the delivery of electronic score reports via the College Board website, integrating with the trend report and essay viewer capability. We are making this change to enable easier download of electronic score report files. The specific details are still being ironed out and we will update you as we finalize the process to access the files.

We are also exploring alternative file delivery formats, including delimited and XML, in addition to the existing fixed-width format detailed below.

**Test Scores**

The redesigned SAT, beginning in March 2016, will contain several new scores, including a total score, new section scores, test, cross-test, and subscores. The total score is on a scale of 400–1600; Evidence-Based Reading and Writing, and Math section scores are on a scale of 200–800, test and cross-test scores are on a scale of 10–40, and subscores are on a scale of 1–15. Additionally, the optional Essay will be reported as three subscores on a scale of 2–8. All scores are whole integers, except the Math test score, which is in 0.5 increments (i.e., 10.0, 10.5, 11.0, etc.). Some of the scores described above should be considered drafts until the research is completed to ensure that they can all be delivered as described. In the layout that follows, draft scores show the note “Availability subject to further research.”

From March 2005 to March 2016, the SAT includes critical reading, mathematics, and writing section scores, reported as three digits on a scale of 200–800, as well as subscores for the essay and writing multiple choice. These scores are still included in the score report file if students who take this version of the test send their scores to you.

To differentiate between the redesigned SAT scores and scores from the pre-2016 SAT, there will be two sets of score fields provided in the layout, one for each group of administration scores. If the scores being provided are from the redesigned SAT, only the redesigned SAT scores and percentile fields will be populated. If the scores being provided are from the pre-2016 SAT, only the scores and percentile fields for the pre-2016 SAT will be populated.

For the redesigned SAT, we will begin including college and career readiness benchmark indicators at the section-level scores; the value of the benchmark scores is pending additional research. As shown in our research, benchmark attainment is related to many positive college outcomes and can be a useful tool in measuring the college readiness of high school students. Like admission test scores, benchmarks are intended to be used by colleges and universities as supplementary to secondary school records and other relevant information, with the benchmarks providing a useful uniform measure for all students.

As in the past, SAT Subject Test scores are reported as three digits on a scale of 200–800 in distinct score fields.

**Percentiles**

The redesigned SAT, beginning in March 2016 during an initial several-year transition period, will begin using two new norm-referenced groups for percentile ranks. National Reference, defined as percentile ranks of a norm-referenced group of all U.S. graduating students, derived via a research study; and U.S. test-taker, comprised of percentile ranks of a norm-referenced group of all U.S. graduating students who typically take the SAT during high school, also derived via a research study.

There will be different percentiles provided for pre-2016 SAT scores. These will continue to be National and State College-Bound Seniors norm-referenced from the prior year’s College-Bound Senior cohort. Pre-2016 percentiles will be in separate fields from redesigned SAT percentiles.

**Major Codes**

The codes for majors are changing to align with Classification of Instruction Programs (CIP) codes provided by the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES). While we will only use a subset of the published codes, we recommend allowing for any CIP codes as we update the SAT-supported values regularly.

**SAT Subject Test Codes**

The codes for the SAT Subject Tests are changing, but the content of the tests has not changed.

<b>Dates</b>	To comply with CEDS, we have updated the format of all date fields to YYYY-MM-DD, using four digits for the year, two digits for the month, and two digits for the day.
<b>Assessment Dates/ Grade Level When Assessed</b>	We report assessment dates, previously referred to as test dates, by year, month, and day (YYYY-MM-DD). Every set of scores reported includes the student's assessment date and grade level when assessed. Grade level when assessed was previously referred to as education level; this is a student self-reported field.
<b>College Code (positions 1–6)</b>	Check that the correct four-digit code has been listed for your institution. If you find an error, your data can be re-created.
<b>Social Security Number (positions 108–116)</b>	Only complete nine-digit numbers appear in this field; incomplete numbers are deleted. Students are not required to provide this information.
<b>Race and Ethnicity (positions 80–97)</b>	Beginning with registrations for the October 2015 SAT, the College Board will ask students a two-part race and ethnicity question. In the candidate score report, we will report both the actual student responses to the question (for collection), and the derived aggregate race and ethnicity as defined by federal guidelines (for reporting). There will be some students who send scores to your institution who will have answered the former version of the race and ethnicity question, which only allowed a student to select one response. In the former version they may have responded "other"; therefore, we will continue to report this option until all students sending scores have answered the new two-part question.
<b>Revised Score (positions 572 and 1070)</b>	Blank = not revised score, Z = revised score. A revised score can occur if a student's assessment needs to be rescored and this results in a new score.
<b>SAT Questionnaire Data (positions 1450–1898)</b>	We report data from the SAT Questionnaire cumulatively for each student. The most recent date, in YYYY-MM-DD format, for which the SAT Questionnaire information was submitted is indicated in positions 1450–1459. Unanswered SAT Questionnaire questions are left blank.
<b>Attending Institution Code (positions 1899–1904)</b>	<p>The Attending Institution (AI) codes, previously referred to as HS codes, will remain the same, but we will no longer enforce numerical assignment of codes, where the first two positions can be used to infer the location, and other positions can be used to infer the school level. Please use "AI Address" fields and "AI School Level" fields going forward to understand these characteristics of the AI.</p> <p>We have modified the available descriptor fields about the AI; please review these fields and their values in the layout that follows.</p>
<b>Number of Advanced Placement Courses Offered (positions 2393–2394)</b>	The data provided in this field are the total number of Advanced Placement (AP) courses offered by the student's high school. The count of AP courses is static, based on the total number of AP courses approved at each high school at the end of the previous academic year. The College Board maintains a list of AP courses for the current school year, released in November and updated through June of that year, which can be found at <a href="https://apcourseaudit.epiconline.org/ledger/">https://apcourseaudit.epiconline.org/ledger/</a> .
<b>Date of Report (positions 2424–2433)</b>	This field indicates the date a student's score record was generated into the file. The date of report, like all other date fields, is in the YYYY-MM-DD format. It can be used to determine the most recent information when multiple records are created for the same student.
<b>Multiple Records</b>	Multiple records are created when a student submits more than one request to send a report to your institution within the same reporting period, or if a student takes the SAT and/or SAT Subject Tests more than once and does not provide consistent identifying information.
