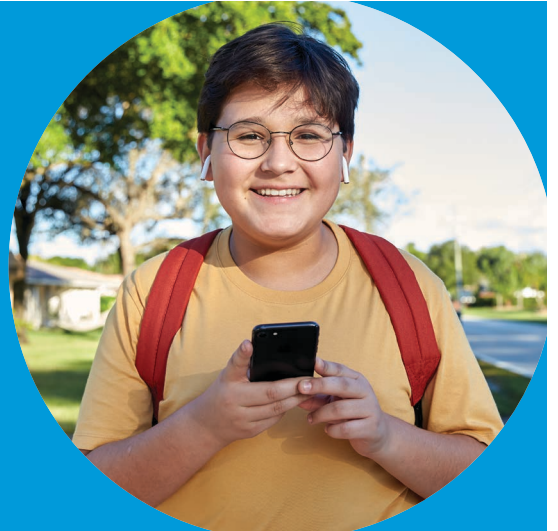


# Start Students on a Path to Success with the **PSAT 8/9**



## Get a College Readiness Baseline

The PSAT™ 8/9 is the first of four tests in the SAT® Suite of Assessments (SAT, PSAT/NMSQT®, PSAT™ 10, and PSAT 8/9). It's designed for eighth- or ninth-grade students and focuses on what evidence shows matters most to ensure students are on track for college and career success. When used together, the SAT Suite of Assessments allow you to monitor growth over time.

## Actionable Data

An online score reporting portal gives you helpful information about your students' college and career readiness. Having this data earlier in a student's school career lets you intervene in time to get more of your students on track for college success. Students 13 and older will also be able to get their detailed score reports online.

## Access to AP

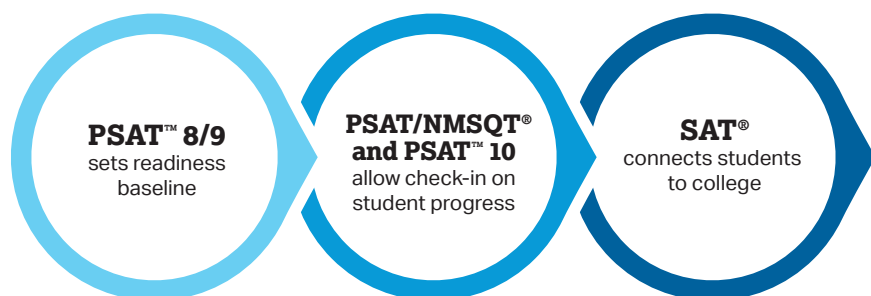

## Complete the Suite

The SAT Suite of Assessments reflects what students are already learning in class and provides benchmarks for assessing students' progress as they enter and move through high school. The tests share a common score scale, making it easier to measure growth.
