

Important Information for Using the **SAT** Score Verification Service

The hand score verification process is performed only once per test, using all information available. If you have information you think could affect the results of the verification process, report it to Customer Service (see below). Once hand score verification results are reported they are final, so give us any additional information you may have when you submit the form.

NOTE: If you took the digital SAT[®], you securely recorded and submitted your multiple-choice responses through the assigned testing device instead of marking an answer sheet with a pencil. Hand score verification of our scanning processes is not available to digital test takers.

WHEN TO CONSIDER REQUESTING SCORE VERIFICATION:

- If your score is very different from what you expected, you may have made an obvious mistake in marking your answers, in which case we will attempt to rescore your test. **Examples of obvious errors:** gridding your answers in the wrong section or marking a skipped question by mistake.
- If you took the Essay (still offered in some state-provided testing) and your essay is blank or completely illegible when you view it in your online score report, you may have written your essay in ink, which doesn't scan properly. We will rescore an essay that didn't scan properly.

IMPORTANT NOTES REGARDING REFUNDS:

Your score verification fee will be refunded only if your score changes because of an irregularity in our scanning and/or scoring processes.

Your score verification fee will not be refunded in the following circumstances:

- If your score doesn't change.
- If your score changes because of an obvious error you made in marking your answer sheet (see above for examples).
- If you wrote your essay in pen, or otherwise failed to follow directions for marking your answers and completing test information.

WHEN YOU MAY NOT WANT TO CONSIDER REQUESTING SCORE VERIFICATION:

- If you didn't mark your multiple-choice answers according to our guidelines, we won't rescore your answer sheet, and your score won't change. Examples of not following the guidelines: using slashes, not completely or darkly filling in the answer bubbles, or not marking the bubbles for your student-produced responses in the Math Test. Some examples of marks that don't conform to our guidelines are below.



- Remember that your score could go down. If your score is fairly close to what you expected to receive, and if you don't think you made any errors in marking your answers, you may want to think twice about incurring the additional cost of score verification.
- If you see your correct essay online and it is readable, you may not want to ask us to verify your Essay score. Essay score verification doesn't include rereading the essay or an appeal of your Essay score.
